			Bob introduced the trustees and staff members.
2.	Adoption of the Agenda	Bob	<b>Motion:</b> It was moved by Karen May and seconded by Terry Waterman that the April 24, 2019 Annual General Meeting agenda be adopted as circulated. Motion carried.
3.	Adoption of the Minutes of the 2018 AGM	Bob	Motion: It was moved by Ryk Allen and seconded by Ann Selfie that the Annual General Meeting minutes of April 21, 2018 be adopted as circulated. Motion carried.

		In the minutes of April 21, 2018 and further to agenda item #5, qRD is not charging an administrative fee to oversee the UBCM grant.  Minor adjustments to the 2018 April 21, 2018 AGM minutes were made to satisfy the line of credit requirements of RBC. Bob Timms was changed to Robert Timms in those minutes.  Motion: It was moved by Walter Gussman and seconded by Ann Selfie to waive the reading of the April 21, 2018 minutes. Motion carried.
4. Report from the Chair	Bob	<ul> <li>Bob Timms presented a summary of the work that VAID has undertaken in 2018. This work included: <ul> <li>Upgrades to the dam as required by the Dam Safety Inspector</li> <li>Successful water workshop held in April 2018 with over 40 people in attendance</li> <li>UBCM grant of \$864,000 was awarded to VAID. Ron Smith will give a report on the project to date.</li> <li>Insurance policy was reviewed.</li> <li>Invoicing and accounting system were updated as required by Central 1 Credit Union.</li> <li>Trustees met with David Duke, auditor to review financial statements. David advised VAID that in the future, we may want to consider a review, rather than a full audit. This would save approximately \$1,000 annually.</li> <li>No Boil Water Advisories in 2018. Ken Soles, water operator was thanked for his diligence and hard work.</li> <li>Bylaws are all being reviewed as time allows.</li> <li>Water Distribution Project with RES EAU WaterNET. This project will allow VAID to optimize water distribution and pressure throughout the community. The data has been compiled, but the report will not be analyzed until after the infrastructure upgrades are complete.</li> <li>In 2019 and beyond, priorities for VAID include revising our 5-year capital works plan, again offer water workshops, identify and repair leaks in our system, and revise our capital infrastructure inventory.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
5. UBCM Grant Update	Ron	Ron updated the ratepayers on the status of the UBCM grant including a time line, financial summary and photos and schematics of the water tank and the water treatment plant. Ron also presented maps showing the location of the new

		infrastructure and the location of the second water line into
		Van Anda.
