OVERVIEW

Introduction and Instructions

The following plan is intended to meet regulatory requirements and provide Van Anda Improvement District staff and trustees with ready information to enable them to respond quickly to events that may affect the continuous supply of safe water. The plan also provides details regarding officials and authorities to be notified in the event of such an emergency.

The Emergency Response Plan is updated annually. Copies of all editions of the Emergency Response Plan will be in hard copy and kept by the Administrator in the Van Anda Improvement District office.

Assignment and Responsibilities

The Chairperson of the Van Anda Improvement District will be the normal coordinator for emergency situations.

In the event the Chairperson is not available, the Senior Water Operator will assume the Coordinator's position. If the Senior Water Operator is not available, the Trustee Delegate #1 will assume the Coordinator's position. In the event Trustee Delegate #1 is not available, the Trustee Delegate #2 will assume the Coordinator's position.

The Emergency Coordinator shall draw upon all available resources to, in the most efficient and expeditious manner, resolve the emergency.

In the event of an emergency the Van Anda Improvement District office at 1400 Marble Bay Road, Van Anda, British Columbia, shall become the Emergency Coordination Center.

CONTACT LISTS

The contact lists are not all inclusive, nor is there any requirement for all telephone numbers (contacts) to be notified for every emergency. It is the responsibility of the Emergency Coordinator to assess which persons and agencies are to be notified. The list should be used in conjunction with the instructions for dealing with specified emergencies.

Water Consumer Notification

If there is a real, immediate threat to the safety of the District's water supply and the Emergency Coordinator is unable to contact the local Environmental Health Officer, Medical Health Officer, or other Ministry of Health Officials for instruction, the following steps should be taken to alert water consumers to the danger:

- If the risk is imminent, the Coordinator should contact local media and local places of business or instruct personnel at the Coordination Center to contact the local media and places of business.
 The message given to local media and places of business for broadcast/posting should include a request that consumers notify their immediate neighbours who may not be aware of the danger.
 Two samples of media announcements are included in the plan.
- 2. Also, if the risk is imminent, the coordinator should contact the water users directly or instruct personnel at the coordination center to contact the water users directly, using the Emergency Contact List which is kept on file in the VAID office. The message given to the water users should include a request that consumers notify their immediate neighbours who may not be aware of the danger.
- 3. An alternate method of customer notification would be the hand delivery of notices indicating the potential danger. Samples of "Advisory Notice" are included in this plan.

LOSS OF SUPPLY (DAMAGE TO SYSTEM)

Actions:

- Ensure system (pump and generator) are shut down.
- Display "Boil Water Advisory" at the Sunshine Coast Fuel Service Station, First Credit Union, Gillies Bay Store, Mary Mary's Café, North Island Princess, BC Ferries, Texada Elementary School, Texada Food Market, Texada Island Inn, Texada Legion, Old School in Gillies Bay, Texada Boat Club, Van Anda Ball Field, Van Anda Post Office
- In case of vandalism, notify RCMP
- Analyze and repair system
- Notify all users
- Contact Vancouver Coastal Health Authority (primary contact: Michael Nguyen)
- Arrange alternate source, if necessary, i.e., bottled water and bulk hauler
- If necessary, disinfect system with chlorine (ask Health Office for instructions)

CHLORINATION FAILURE

Actions:

- Notify Water Operators
- Display "Boil Water Advisory" at Sunshine Coast Fuel Service Station, First Credit Union, Gillies Bay Store, Mary Mary's Café, North Island Princess, BC Ferries, Texada Elementary School, Texada Food Market, Texada Island Inn, Texada Legion, Old School in Gillies Bay, Texada Boat Club, Van Anda Ball Field, Van Anda Post Office
- In case of vandalism, notify RCMP
- Analyze and repair system. (A complete set of spares is on hand at the chlorination facility)
- A direct application to the tank of 1.8 Litres 5% bleach will increase the chlorine by
 0.5 ppm max. This can be tested after 30 minutes and re-applied if necessary
- If untreated water has entered the system, issue Boil Advisory.
- Notify Trustees and Drinking Water Officer
- Flush system until suitable disinfection levels are achieved
- Notify all users

BROKEN WATER MAIN

Actions:

- Reduce pressure to broken section (but maintain enough pressure to backflow) by closing the gate-valves. (See the Map and Water Line binder located in the second drawer of the left file cabinet. File cabinet drawer labeled "Information Books
- Display "Boil Water Advisory" at Sunshine Coast Fuel Service Station, First Credit Union, Gillies Bay Store, Mary Mary's Café, North Island Princess, BC Ferries, Texada Elementary School, Texada Food Market, Texada Island Inn, Texada Legion, Old School in Gillies Bay, Texada Boat Club, Van Anda Ball Field, Van Anda Post Office
- Notify all users of interruption of service
- Call for repairs, i.e., plumber, excavator
- Advise Vancouver Coastal Health Authority (primary contact: Michael Nguyen)
- Arrange alternate source, if necessary, i.e., bottled water and bulk hauler

STORAGE TANK FAILURE

Actions:

- Switch the bypass over to divert the water passed the storage tank in order to ensure that the village would still have water to their households
- Clarify with Vancouver Coastal Health Authority (primary contact: Michael Nguyen) if system should be shut down or a "Boil Water Advisory" be issued
- Notify all users
- Display "Boil Water Advisory" at the Sunshine Coast Fuel Service Station, Texada Island Inn, First Credit Union - Texada Branch, Texada Elementary School, Van Anda Post Office, Texada Food Market, Texada Boat Club, Texada Legion and the North Island Princess, BC Ferries
- Contact local media for public service announcement
- Arrange alternate source, if necessary, i.e., bottled water and bulk hauler.

MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT - FUEL SPILL INTO THE LAKE

Actions:

- Contact Van Anda Volunteer Fire Department and Gillies Bay Volunteer Fire Department to deploy spill kits
- Contact Water Operator to deploy spill kit from chlorination building
- Contact Emergency Coordination Centre which will forward call to Environmental Emergency Response Office – or call 911
- Clarify with Vancouver Coastal Health Authority (primary contact: Michael Nguyen if system should be shut down or a "Boil Water Advisory" be issued
- Notify all users.
- Display "Boil Water Advisory" at the Sunshine Coast Fuel Service Station, First
 Credit Union, Gillies Bay Store, Mary Mary's Café, North Island Princess, BC Ferries,
 Texada Elementary School, Texada Food Market, Texada Island Inn, Texada Legion,
