Water Report	SH	<ul> <li>Lake level stable at -2"</li> <li>Water usage 80,000 – 100,000 USG per day</li> <li>VCH test results showed coliforms lower than usual for this time of year – prob from bypassing 50-year-old intake line that may never have been cleaned.</li> <li>After cleaning, add cap to intake to protect from sunlight. Clean pipe using "sewer jetting" equipment – PR City has one. BCHydro uses similar for "digless" lines. Have diver on-hand to clean out vertical section. Is Al Davis helping?</li> <li>Is Wall St samples station still trickling water? Prev left on to help balance chlorine. Check with AR</li> <li>Plant designed to allow for 10% waste for flushing. SH check data to determine waste quantity.</li> <li>Adding 3rd filter system may allow increased quantity of water treated. System designed for small filters and cartridges than what we are using. Ask Res'eau about pre-filter – would be sand. Also ask Grant Robertson Homeplus. Provide collected experience over year to help.
